



- December 2019, 24th, Yann Stotz, a professional entertainer/humorist posted the video on his official Instagram account as an "ephemeral broadcast"
- A sketch already performed on stage for months by Stotz
- A bad quality photocopy of *Mein Kampf* front cover pasted on another book
- Stotz himself claims the video to be a hoax and poke fun about sounds-like words ("c'est pareil") and generational misunderstanding
- The joke already exists in English... since, at least, June 2019 on memecenter.com







Situational elements

X-mas context: busy people just glance at the video (low attention)

• Taped - and mostly shared - *via* smartphones: low quality, small screen, etc.

• A wrong present offered for X-mas sounds familiar to many people

generational quid pro quo and misunderstandings happen a lot



Global / political context

- Liberalization of re-printing *Mein Kampf* in France: Fayard (mainstream publisher) announced the publication for 2020, Kontre Kulture (far right publisher) in 2016
- Huge media coverage on antisemitic assassinations and acts in France in 2019 : Sarah Halimi's murder trial, Jewish graveyard vandalized in Alsace, Simone Veil's portrait desecrated, etc.

- The video quickly spreads on the internet with no mention of its origins and author
- Overcomes the language barrier in a couple of hours



- Celebrities share the video on social networks. E.g.: Joey Star
- The video became viral on different social medias: Facebook, YouTube, or WhatsApp
- Facebook and Instagram censored the original video on Stotz accounts for "incitement to hatred"
- People comments were either amused, sad, or chocked

From Hoax to Fake News



- The video is a typical case of transgeneric and semantic shifts of the expression fake news in relation with hoax
- In the 1990's, fake news referred to genuine *flase* news made on purpose to mock mainstream media or political institutions. E.g.: *The Onion* or *The Daily Show with Jon Stewart*, etc.(Baym 2005; Natella 2006; Reilley 2018)
- Fake news were very similar to hoax or parody, and the public was fully aware that what is presented to be real is actually false (Harsin 2018)
- **Problem:** what happen when the narrative compass between the producer and the receivers, including mainstream media, is broken because humor is no longer perceived (*per se*)?
- Facing the development of popular journalism that challenges their gate-keeping function, mainstream media are more and more prone to immediately consider hoaxes, parody, mockery, or irony as dis/misinformation, forgery, falsification, and fake news



The Trump factor: 73 uses of "fake news" between December 16th 2016 and July 24th 2017 (Rosen 2017); Trump told "fake news" 16 times a day in June and July 2018
